3. **Inclusion**

Do not be haughty, but associate with the lowly. Never be wise in your own sight (v. 16b).

- If it wasn't **beneath** your Master, it can't be **beneath** you.
- Pride makes a group dysfunctionally **hierarchical**, while love shows the value that people **actually** have.
